Ground-breaking Ceremonies Are Conducted By Cogar Corp.

WAPPINGERS FALLS — Ground-breaking ceremonies were conducted Thursday at the site for the Cogar Corp. Technology Division plant near the intersection of Myers Corners and All Angels roads.



George Cogar, president of the firm, said he anticipates 200 persons will be employed here by the first of the year.

Cogar Corp., a Utica-based firm, plans to invest more than \$3 million in the plant here.

It will be used for research and development of technology for use in data processing.

Occupancy is anticipated by this fall.

Cogar said "As individuals and as a company we are sensitive to the feelings and concerns of some Town of Wappinger residents and ask an opportunity to contribute to the community's wellbeing."

The division headquarters are now located at 22 Oakley St., Poughkeepsie; where 70 persons are employed in development of data processing technology.
